❖ ***Introduction***

- BT is a Faith Based NGO Dedicated exclusively to the provision of safe water, sanitation and hygiene education in the rural communities of Uganda.
- In the last 20 years the organization has constructed over 1800 sources in the districts of Jinja, Iganga, Kamuli, Mayuge, Bugiri, Kaliro, Luwero, Mpigi and Nakasongola

❖ ***Mission***

- To contribute to poverty alleviation through timely delivery of services to improve the life of rural communities by providing sustainable safe water with adequate sanitation in collaboration with the church of Uganda and other development partners

❖ ***Activities***

- Construction of shallow wells, springs and rain water harvesting at household and institutional level
- Sanitation and hygiene promotion (soft and hardware)
- Hydro geological surveys
- Water quality analysis
- On going support-refresher and maintenance training
- Dissemination and advocacy of the best practices to policy makers/implementers

❖ *Overview the field visit to Busoga Trust*
