Dear Mr Lyim,

It is in this spirit that I write to assure you that you, your church, and the people of Taiwan are being held in prayer by brothers and sisters within this global fellowship of churches. As we share the cross which you have graciously given, we shall invite others to pray with and for you as you continue to serve those in need particularly at this difficult time. We journey with you now and as we continue on the pilgrimage of justice and peace.
