Statement by Top Leaders of Inter-Religious Council of Ethiopia (IRCE) on the Current Situation of Ethiopia

To the Honorable People of our Country

First and foremost, we extend our deepest and heartfelt condolences to the families and relatives of those victimized citizens in the brutal murder in the part of our country.

- 2. Honorable Prosperity Party and TPLF Leaders, we call upon you to resolve your political disagreements through open discussion.
- 3. Distinguished Religious Fathers at all levels, we urge you to ensure your paternal responsibility to resolve the conflict through peaceful dialogue and negotiation, recognizing that the ongoing civil war between the two parties will have awful consequences.
- 4. We call on you dear elders, Abagadas, fathers/mothers, and all influential bodies of the society to ensure that the conflict between the country's citizens does not escalate and that both sides come to an agreement peacefully.

- 7. Dear Youth, We urge you to refrain from aggravating the current conflict as it is between the citizens of our country, Ethiopia.
- 8. Distinguished members of the security forces and leaders, we urge you to handle the situation with great wisdom and understanding, as well as patiently.

Finally, to exterminate the spirit of hatred and evil which is now seen in our country, we all need to turn our attention to The Creator as the principle of our beliefs. Knowing this, we urge you to preserve a week of pray starting from tomorrow, 5th November 2020.
