

Informe del Secretario General en funciones

Estimada moderadora, estimados vicemoderadores, miembros, asesores y colegas, Sus Eminencias, Sus Excelencias, queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

El mundo ha cambiado de maneras que no podíamos imaginar cuando el Comité Central se reunió por última vez en Ginebra en 2018. Por la gracia de Dios estamos juntos de nuevo, para celebrar la primera reunión en línea del Comité Central. Le estoy agradecido a cada uno de ustedes por dar prioridad a la presente reunión.

Quiero dar las gracias a nuestro ex secretario general, obispo Olav Fykse Tveit, por su aliento espiritual en el día de hoy y por su liderazgo en una época de cambios sin precedentes. Junto a nuestra moderadora, dirigió la respuesta del CMI al principio de la pandemia, alentando a las iglesias a que hicieran todo lo posible por proteger la vida. Obispo Olav, su legado continúa guiándonos y le estamos agradecidos.

Quiero dar las gracias a los dirigentes del Comité Central y los miembros del Comité Ejecutivo por su enorme compromiso. Hicimos frente a muchos desafíos el año pasado y su liderazgo ofreció estabilidad y orientación. Quiero también expresar mi profunda gratitud al personal del CMI, cuyos miembros fueron los primeros en utilizar nuevas formas de involucrar a nuestras iglesias miembros y asociados ecuménicos.

Cuando me pidieron asumir la responsabilidad de secretario general en funciones, se pensaba que sería por poco tiempo. Ya ha pasado más de un año, y mi mandato fue prorrogado hasta el final del próximo año para garantizar y coordinar los preparativos de la próxima Asamblea. Junto a ustedes, sigo comprometido a liderar el Consejo mientras continuamos la peregrinación de justicia y paz hasta la 11^a Asamblea del próximo año en Karlsruhe (Alemania).

Mi informe será breve. Desde mayo del año pasado, hemos publicado y compartido con ustedes informes de rendición de cuentas cada mes. Eso nos ha mantenido más unidos en un momento de distancia física. Los informes muestran cómo nos adaptamos y lo relevante que es nuestra labor por la unidad y la reconciliación. En el presente informe quiero centrarme en cómo nos hemos adaptado y cómo nos inspira el tema de la Asamblea, porque en medio de la pandemia, hemos visto cómo “*el amor de Cristo lleva al mundo a la reconciliación y la unidad*”.

El CMI en época de pandemia

Como elocuentemente describió nuestra moderadora, la pandemia de la COVID-19 tomó por sorpresa al mundo. Sigue causando un enorme sufrimiento y exacerbando las desigualdades existentes y emergentes. El mundo entero se sigue viendo afectado. Nuestra unidad, como una familia humana y como una comunidad de iglesias, es más importante que nunca.

Estamos viviendo una época de gran sufrimiento. Nuestras iglesias han perdido a muchos miembros y dirigentes. Pero como personas de fe, seguimos esperanzados, pues nuestro Señor Jesucristo ha resucitado, venciendo a la muerte y dando vida y un significado y un sentido nuevos al mundo.

Las iglesias miembros han sido increíblemente resilientes y han mostrado una gran capacidad de respuesta durante la pandemia. Cada uno de ustedes es parte de este discipulado transformado y transformador que ha mantenido dinámica y viva a la iglesia.

La pandemia sigue afectando a toda la comunidad. Para la Secretaría del CMI, la pandemia ha supuesto apoyar a las iglesias miembros a afrontar la pandemia, aplazando un año la Asamblea y adaptando nuestra manera de trabajar.

Lo que nos ha inspirado es el amor de Dios en Cristo por toda la creación y el objetivo principal del CMI como comunidad de iglesias que se exhortan unas a otras a “*alcanzar la unidad visible en una sola fe y una sola comunión eucarística, expresada en el culto y la vida común en Cristo*” (artículo III de la Constitución del CMI).

El Plan Estratégico del CMI continúa orientando nuestra labor en una época de cambios. La peregrinación de justicia y paz es una dirección estratégica importante que mantiene unida a la comunidad. Hemos aprendido muchas cosas en los últimos dos años. En la propuesta de ampliación del Plan Estratégico (GEN PRO 03) se recogen algunas de las importantes lecciones aprendidas. Me gustaría destacar algunas de las cosas que creo que es importante que tengamos presentes mientras trabajamos juntos esta semana.

Los límites impuestos por la pandemia empujaron al CMI a lograr muchas cosas de maneras diferentes. La adaptación más relevante fue la mayor utilización del trabajo en línea. Aunque anhelamos reunirnos en persona, vemos un futuro en el que las metodologías híbridas ofrecen nuevas oportunidades de colaboración.

La pandemia ofreció la oportunidad de establecer más comunicación con las iglesias miembros y los asociados. Ha aumentado la cooperación regional, especialmente con las organizaciones ecuménicas regionales. Esto contribuye a mantener a las iglesias en el centro de nuestros esfuerzos comunes. Las consultas regionales sobre la COVID-19 de la peregrinación de justicia y paz son un ejemplo de una nueva etapa en la atención conjunta a la comunidad.

Mientras muchas iglesias se adaptaron a la oración y el culto en línea, el CMI también se adaptó ofreciendo oportunidades para la oración mundial, la oración regional y la oración diaria. Esta ha sido una de las tendencias más innovadoras: estar más profundamente conectados a través de la oración, orar los unos por los otros y orar juntos por nuestras iglesias y nuestro mundo.

La pandemia ha dado más visibilidad a muchas desigualdades existentes, sobre todo al pecado del racismo. Antes de la pandemia, estábamos planificando relanzar la labor del CMI en la lucha contra el racismo después de la Asamblea. La pandemia nos mostró que no podíamos esperar porque, en Cristo, cada vida cuenta. Debería ser una prioridad para cada uno de nosotros involucrar a las iglesias en la lucha contra el racismo, la discriminación racial y la xenofobia. En enero de este año se creó un nuevo puesto y un nuevo Programa de Lucha contra el Racismo.

Mucho de nuestro trabajo continuó con buenos resultados, pero nuestra labor de construcción de la paz, especialmente en Tierra Santa, afrontó múltiples desafíos. Actividades como el Programa Ecuménico de Acompañamiento en Palestina e Israel se vieron afectadas de manera significativa. Estoy muy orgulloso de cómo respondimos escuchando las necesidades y expectativas de las iglesias locales y trabajando con los dirigentes locales de iglesias y nuestros asociados en el empeño de la construcción de la paz para redefinir, consolidar y fortalecer las actividades que el CMI realiza en Jerusalén.

En Ginebra, la obra del Green Village comenzó en marzo de 2020 en el Centro Ecuménico, operando bajo las normas contra la COVID. Aunque el mercado inmobiliario ha sufrido presiones, se han hecho buenos avances hacia el logro de nuestros objetivos con respecto al proyecto de desarrollo inmobiliario.

Aunque la pandemia conllevó problemas financieros, la generosidad de las iglesias miembros y los asociados ecuménicos nos ha ayudado a continuar nuestra labor y preparar a nuestra comunidad para la Asamblea.

El CMI se prepara para la Asamblea

Estamos llenos de esperanza de que nos reuniremos el próximo año en Karlsruhe y eso es lo que estamos planificando, incluyendo diferentes escenarios de requisitos sanitarios y de salud. Les quiero asegurar que el Comité Ejecutivo, junto con las iglesias anfitrionas, está siguiendo de cerca la situación, confiando en los datos y el asesoramiento de los expertos en salud.

Estoy agradecido al Comité de Planificación de la Asamblea bajo la dirección de Su Eminencia el metropolitano Gennadios de Sássima por su dedicación. También estoy agradecido por la labor del Comité de Planificación de Cultos de la Asamblea bajo la dirección de la Rev. Dra. Elisabeth Krause-Vilmar.

El informe del Comité de Planificación de la Asamblea (GEN PRO 02) presenta la visión de una Asamblea profundamente arraigada en el tema: *“El amor de Cristo lleva al mundo a la reconciliación y la unidad”*. Propone un orden del día que involucrará a los delegados en la oración, la reflexión, la conversación y la acción. Se ha trabajado mucho y estamos en el camino correcto hacia una gran Asamblea.

El tema ha adquirido un nuevo significado por la experiencia de la pandemia. Nuestra teología trinitaria – que se ha desarrollado, formulado y acordado durante décadas en documentos del CMI – nos ayuda a ver el amor de Cristo en el contexto del amor del Dios trino por el mundo entero que se manifestó plenamente en la encarnación, en Jesucristo.

Cuando se habla del amor de Cristo, se habla del amor kenótico e indiscriminado de Dios en Cristo por toda la creación. Esta es la esencia misma de nuestra fe. Al tomar esta dirección, también hemos reafirmado la dirección de Entendimiento y Visión Comunes del CMI, que exponía que la reconciliación y la unidad son el objetivo final de Dios en Cristo para la humanidad y la creación (Colosenses 1:19) y se exemplifica con la compasión de Cristo por los que sufren en Mateo (9:35-39) y en muchos otros pasajes de los cuatro Evangelios. Esta perspectiva abrió vías teológicas sólidas de diálogo y cooperación con el mundo.

La reflexión sobre el tema de la Asamblea publicada en línea en enero desarrolla esta interpretación en el contexto de aquello a lo que se enfrentan las iglesias y el mundo hoy, sobre todo:

- la COVID-19 y sus consecuencias;
- la emergencia climática;
- el racismo y las crecientes desigualdades sociales y económicas;
- el debilitamiento de la democracia por las políticas autoritarias del miedo y del odio; y
- las ambiguas consecuencias de la revolución digital.

El amor de Cristo abre el horizonte de la esperanza. Como comunidad de iglesias, seguimos siendo fieles a nuestro objetivo fundacional: promover la unidad cristiana para que el mundo crea. Al mismo tiempo, es igual de importante reiterar que el objetivo de Dios en Cristo es llevar al mundo entero y a todo el cosmos a la reconciliación y la unidad. Mientras la comunidad del CMI se prepara para reunirse en Karlsruhe (Alemania) con motivo de la 11^a Asamblea, la experiencia de las iglesias dando respuesta a una pandemia mundial seguirá determinando nuestro entendimiento de cómo *“el amor de Cristo lleva al mundo a la reconciliación y la unidad”*.

El orden del día del Comité Central del CMI

Como afirmó la moderadora, el orden del día de nuestra primera reunión en línea es limitado. Esperamos lograr tres objetivos importantes:

1. Fortalecer nuestra comunidad al compartir y orar juntos.
2. Recibir las solicitudes de admisión en el CMI, reconocer a nuevos asociados ecuménicos y abordar otras cuestiones relativas a la condición de miembro.
3. Avanzar juntos hacia la 11^a Asamblea del CMI en Karlsruhe (Alemania).

También les pedimos que amplíen el período del Plan Estratégico, la Estrategia Financiera y la Estrategia de Comunicación para que incluyan el año 2022. Las estrategias nos han sido muy útiles. Siguen guiándonos durante la pandemia y nos ayudan a prepararnos para la Asamblea.

A petición del Comité Ejecutivo, incluyo en mi informe una lista de asuntos pendientes que el Comité Central todavía no ha tratado. Quiero asegurarles que no se ha perdido nada. La lista nos recuerda que hay más trabajo por hacer antes de llegar a Karlsruhe. Si Dios quiere nos reuniremos en persona a principios de 2022 para completar nuestro trabajo.

Conclusión

La situación sanitaria mundial sigue presentando muchos desafíos. Sin embargo, con fe y esperanza, continuamos nuestra peregrinación y afirmamos que Dios es el Señor de la historia, Gobernante del universo, y que la intención revelada de Dios es aportar vida, unidad y reconciliación al mundo entero. Nosotros, como mayordomos, cuidadores y colaboradores de la misión de Dios, seguimos avanzando, orando y trabajando para que se cumpla su voluntad. Recordamos la promesa firme de Cristo a los discípulos: “Y yo estaré con ustedes todos los días, hasta el fin del mundo” (Mateo 28:20).
