Events may include musical or cultural performances, visual arts, talk shows, storytelling, etc. Proposed events should be artistically appealing to a broad spectrum of participants, rooted in the theme of the assembly and connect with relevant issues.

At the assembly, there are two performance stages in the Brunnen area – one is accessible to the public and the other is open to assembly participants only.

Performances spots are available for different durations – from 5 minutes to 30 minutes. Performances take place daily between 11:00 and 21:00 on Wednesday, 31 August; Thursday, 1 September; Friday, 2 September; Monday, 5 September; Tuesday, 6 September; and Wednesday, 7 September.
