The message of Rev Prof Dr Jerry Pillay, general secretary of the World Council of Churches, to the 68th General Assembly Meeting of the Presbyterian Church in Taiwan (PCT)

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

On behalf of the WCC and the global ecumenical movement, I bring you warm greetings on the occasion of the 68th General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in Taiwan (PCT). As a member of the WCC since 1951, with its 158-year dynamic legacy in Taiwan, the PCT is a profoundly inspiring church to the global ecumenical movement. The PCT embodies a contextual and holistic Mission by sharing the Gospel and consistently promoting social justice, peace, healing, education, human rights, and indigenous peoples' rights. May the Holy Spirit lead and guide your thoughts and decisions and may your time together be fruitful as you fellowship, worship, pray and discern together God's continued direction for the PCT.
