Proposed Nominations for Commissions and Joint Consultative Bodies revised

Introduction

In January 2022 the acting general secretary wrote to all member churches asking for nominations for commissions and joint consultative bodies. A reminder was sent in June 2022. The secretariat recorded over 400 nominations (available upon request).

There are six WCC commissions. The central committee approves commission bylaws and elects commission members. Commissions have a special status given their histories and the wider constituency represented in their structure either as members or advisors. Commissions report to the central committee.

The bylaws of each commission define its respective membership, including size and in some cases the participation of ecumenical partners. Some bylaws stipulate nomination processes, i.e. Faith and Order, Mission and Evangelism.

Joint consultative bodies, such as the Joint Working Group with Roman Catholic Church and the Joint Consultative Group with Pentecostal Churches, are particular initiatives between the WCC and churches or church traditions not directly represented in WCC membership. The central committee elects WCC representatives on joint consultative bodies. They report to both parent bodies.

In developing draft slates, the assembly recommendations regarding the formation of commission have been observed, i.e. priority for young people nominated for central committee, but not elected; and consideration of churches not represented on central committee. Particular attention was given to fair and adequate representation of women and men, lay and ordained, youth, persons with disabilities and Indigenous Persons. The targets for regional representation and church family representation have been respected.

No individual is proposed for more than one commission or joint consultative body, with the exception of Young People in the Ecumenical Movement because it includes young people on each commission. No member church is represented by more than one person on each commission or joint consultative body.

Nominations from the Roman Catholic Church for commissions and for the Joint Working Group are in process. The Pentecostal World Fellowship will be asked to name the Pentecostals on the Joint Consultative Group.

What follows are slates for consideration and election. Each slate is introduced with an excerpt from the respective bylaws indicating the aim of commission and requirements for membership.

I. Commission on Faith and Order

Faith and Order represents an historic, founding movement of the WCC and incorporates the participation of the Roman Catholic Church and other non-member churches of the WCC in the organizing and staffing of its activities within the overall framework of the WCC. The primary purpose of the Commission on Faith and Order is to serve the churches as they call one another to visible unity in one faith and in one Eucharistic fellowship, expressed in worship and common life in Christ, through witness and service to the world, and advance towards that unity in order that the world may believe.

The Commission shall consist of no fewer than 40 members and no more than 60 members (including the Moderator and Vice-Moderators). The Commission, by its last meeting before each Assembly of the WCC, shall appoint a nominations committee to prepare a list of names, from those nominated by their churches, for the election of the new commission by the Central Committee at its first full meeting after the Assembly. The Commission, at the last meeting of its mandate after each assembly, shall nominate a person as moderator of Faith and Order for election by the Central Committee at its first full meeting after the assembly.

II. Commission on World Mission and Evangelism

In continuity with the functions formerly carried out by the International Missionary Council and articulated in the Common Understanding and Vision of the WCC, the aims of the commission are: (1) To carry out the aim of the conference: "to assist the Christian community in the proclamation of the gospel of Jesus Christ, by word and deed, to the whole world to the end that all may believe in him and be saved"; and (2) To facilitate the common witness of the churches in each place and in all places and to help them support each other in their local, national and worldwide work of mission and evangelism.

The commission shall consist of not more than thirty persons appointed by the central committee. The outgoing commission on world mission and evangelism shall submit nominations at the appropriate time, to the central committee, for the moderator and for membership of the commission, which shall include (a) the majority drawn from the member churches of the WCC; (b) about 25% should be chosen from those nominated by the affiliated bodies of the conference; (c) the remaining members should be drawn from a wider constituency. The outgoing commission shall propose six persons among its members to serve another term, and submit their names to the central committee for the continuity of the commission's work.

III. Commission on Education and Ecumenical Formation

Ecumenical Education and Formation represents a significant historical strand of the ecumenical movement. Ecumenical education and formation are at the heart of the concerns of churches, congregations, councils, ecumenical organizations, movements and individuals and enable them to participate in the ecumenical vocation and imperative.

The Commission shall be composed of no more than 30 members appointed by the central committee. They shall be elected after each assembly and shall hold office until the following assembly. The leadership of the commission shall be the moderator and a vice-moderator, who shall be elected by the central committee.

IV. Commission of the Churches on International Affairs

The Commission will call the attention of churches and councils to problems which are especially claimant upon the Christian conscience at any particular time and suggest ways in which Christians may act effectively upon those problems in their respective countries and internationally and respond to issues raised by churches and national and regional ecumenical organizations.

The Commission shall be composed of not more than 30 members out of which one quarter should be members of the outgoing commission in order to ensure continuity and, ex officio, the Director of the Commission of the Churches on International Affairs. The Leadership of the Commission shall be the Moderator, who shall be elected by the Central Committee, a Vice-Moderator, who shall be elected by the Commission, and, ex officio, and the Director of the Commission.

V. Young People in the Ecumenical Movement Commission

The commission aims to ensure that the prophetic voices of young people are present and heard within the WCC; and to empower young people through networking and ecumenical commitment on various levels. The Commission shall ensure fair and adequate representation, and consist of at least 20 up to 30 young people between 18 and 30 years old with the following composition:

- If applicable, at least six (6) members from the Central Committee shall be commissioners. If applicable, at least two (2) among these six (6) shall be from the Executive Committee.*
- If applicable, at least two (2) members shall be appointed from each WCC Commission.*
- The other members of the Commission may consist of young persons from the WCC consultative bodies, member churches, and ecumenical partner organizations, and they shall have the same right to speak and participate in decision-making.*

All Commissioners shall be under the age of thirty (30) at the beginning of the term. Only persons nominated by the member church and ecumenical partner organization to which he or she belongs can be elected as a member by the central committee. At least two members of the outgoing leadership of the commission who served during the previous period shall be invited to the first full meeting of the newly-elected YPEM commission following an assembly, as advisors to the meeting, in order to offer continuity in the work of the commission. The Commission shall have a moderator elected by the Central Committee. Four (4) vice-moderators shall be elected from amongst the other Commissioners. At least one (1) vice-moderator shall be from the Central Committee.

VI. Commission on Health and Healing

The commission shall mobilise and accompany member churches to become learning and healing communities to take holistic action, especially prioritising health promotion, disease prevention and diaconal service, in collaboration with other actors. The commission will assist the council in calling the attention of member churches and ecumenical partners to gaps and challenges on health and diaconal matters and suggest ways in which Christians may act effectively upon those issues in their respective communities, countries and internationally.

The commission shall be composed of not more than 25 members nominated by member churches and ecumenical partners. One quarter should be members of the outgoing commission in order to ensure continuity. One additional member shall be nominated by the Pontifical Council for the Promotion of Christian Unity. The leadership of the commission shall be the moderator, who shall be elected by the central committee, a vice-moderator, who shall be elected by the commission, and the WCC director for the commission.

VII. Joint Working Group between the WCC and the Roman Catholic Church

It is to be explored in doctrinal reflections and dialogues, anticipated in joint action and experienced through participation in common prayer and the spiritual life of each other in helpful and appropriate ways. The leadership includes two co-moderators, one from the WCC and one from the Roman Catholic Church. The central committee elects the members and co-moderator representing the WCC.

VIII. Joint Consultative Group between the WCC and Pentecostal Churches

The Joint Consultative Group is a platform for discussion, mutual encouragement, understanding and cooperation between Pentecostal churches and member churches of the World Council of Churches (WCC). The Harare Assembly (1998) established the Joint Consultative Group, recognizing the growing need to consolidate existing relations and create new ones; to initiate study on issues of common interest, to explore different forms of participation; and to encourage collaboration. The Porto Alegre Assembly (2006) recognized "the visible contribution of the Pentecostal churches in the dynamically changing Christian landscape, and the importance to the ecumenical movement of engaging in mutual learning and sustained dialogue with the Pentecostal churches".

The Joint Working Group is comprised of two teams of equal size representing WCC member churches and Pentecostal churches. The leadership includes two co-moderators, one from the WCC and one from the Pentecostal churches. The central committee elects the members and co-moderator representing the WCC.
